Formulation and Storage


Formulation	Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 8% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge the tube before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 µg/ml is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
Storage	-20 to -80°C for 24 months as supplied from date of receipt80°C for 3 months after reconstitution.Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Background

Interleukin 7 (IL-7) and its receptor (IL-7R, a heterodimer of IL-7R α and γ c) are essential for normal lymphoid development. IL-7 and IL-7R activate three main pathways: STAT5, PI3K/Akt/mTOR and MEK/Erk, ultimately leading to the promotion of leukemia cell viability, cell cycle progression and growth.




Mouse IL-7R alpha on Bis-Tris PAGE under reduced condition. The purity is greater than 95%.




The purity of Mouse IL-7R alpha is greater than 95% as determined by SEC-HPLC.
